Call for Conference Speakers and Poster Submissions

We invite proposals for Talks, Forums, and Posters addressing topics in all areas of threat assessment and management, including assessment or management of any form of violence (e.g., general violence, domestic violence, stalking, workplace and school violence, sexual violence, and terrorism) and legal, policy, or ethical issues.

The Presentation Selection Committee will evaluate all proposals using objective criteria. All proposals must utilize the CATAP 2020 Annual Conference Submission Form (attached).

TALKS (60, 90 or 240 min): A presentation focused on one topic. Submissions should be made using the proposal form. Typically, talks are presented by a single speaker. Co-presenters may be proposed if needed to make a significant contribution to the presentation.

FORUMS (90 or 240 min): A single-topic coordinated group of verbal presentations with a minimum of three presentations and an independent discussant.

POSTERS: Poster presentations are made in written format on display boards (size TBA).

There is a limit of TWO submissions per person per category. Authors will be notified of acceptance status no later than May 31st, 2020. Primary speakers will be awarded travel funds to attend the conference.

CATAP 2020 Annual Conference Submission Form

TALKS (60, 90 or 240 min): A presentation focused on one topic. Typically, talks are presented by a single speaker. Co-presenters may be proposed if needed to make a significant contribution to the presentation. Presentations of case studies with clear implications for operational practice, research focused talks, and presentations that advance understanding of legal or ethical issues germane to the field are encouraged. Submissions are limited to a 100-word abstract and 1000-word summary.

FORUMS (90 or 240 min): A single-topic coordinated group of verbal presentations with a minimum of three presentations and an independent discussant. Submissions are limited to a 200-word abstract and 2000-word summary. A forum could be presented in the evening as a Fireside Chat at the discretion of the Presentation Selection Committee.

POSTERS: Poster presentations are made in written format on display boards (size TBA). Submissions are limited to a 100-word abstract and 1000-word summary.

The Presentation Selection Committee will evaluate all proposals on the following criteria (using a 1 to 5 rating scale):

1. Relevance of contribution to the field of threat assessment and management;
2. Contribution to the operational knowledge of threat assessment and management;
3. Degree to which data were collected with clear and appropriate methodology and analysis (for data-based submissions);
4. Likelihood of generating discussion at the conference that will benefit the field;
5. Clarity of description of information to be presented for the time proposed;
6. Breadth of appeal to anticipated audience.
