- Addressing gender bias in threat assessment and management (TAM);
- Cultural considerations in TAM including Indigenous perspectives;
- Case formulation and communication of risk:
- · Case studies inclusive of lessons learned;
- The assessment and management of sexual violence;
- When multiple risks are present;
- Personality Disorders and other mental health issues related to TAM;
- Legal, policy, and/or ethical issues; and
- Any other topic related to general violence, domestic violence, gang violence, stalking, terrorism, and workplace and school violence, etc.

CATAP 2023 Annual Conference Submission Form

TALK/FORUM

(60, 90 or 120 minutes):

A presentation focused on one topic. Typically, talks are presented by a single speaker. Co-presenters may be allowed if needed to make a significant contribution to the presentation.

Submissions are limited to a 100-word abstract and 1000-word summary.

Accepted speakers will receive complimentary attendance at the 2023 Conference and shuttle to and from the venue

POSTER

Poster presentations are to be made in written format on display boards (size TBA). Submissions are limited to a 100-word abstract and 1000-word summary.

The Presentation Selection Committee will evaluate <u>all</u> proposals on the following criteria (using a 1 to 5 rating scale):

- 1. Relevance of contribution to the field of threat assessment and management;
- 2. Contribution to the operational knowledge of threat assessment and management;
- 3. Degree to which data were collected with clear and appropriate methodology and analysis (for data-based submissions);
- 4. Likelihood of generating discussion at the conference that will benefit the field;
- 5. Clarity of description of information to be presented for the time proposed; and
- 6. Breadth of appeal to anticipated audience.
